Gray School is an urban school situated in Palmerston with a student population of approximately 310 including Preschool. The school community has a large number of Aboriginal and English as a second language families. The school is driven by its school motto that is 'Together, there are no limits to what we can achieve' and promotes high achievement in a safe, disciplined and caring environment. The school has operational plans and an attendance plan in place that reflects the priorities of addressing student attendance and student achievement levels.

Key duties and responsibilities

1. In collaboration with the Leadership Team provide leadership and coaching to teachers in the development and implementation of quality curriculum and assessment procedures, behaviour management, ICT and student wellbeing.
2. Provide educational leadership and team management to promote an efficient, productive and harmonious working environment.
3. Demonstrate leadership in and support for the development, implementation and review of school policies, procedures and strategic planning through collaboration with all stakeholders.
4. In collaboration with the Leadership Team assist in the delivery and implementation of the goals in the school Annual School Improvement Plan.
